This term we are learning...

This half term our theme is 'Pirates'. As historians, the children will be learning about the life of Captain Blackbeard and comparing that to modern day sailors. As geographers, children will be learning about the 7 continents and oceans of the world. As part of our creative work, the children will be creating observational drawings of pirate ships.

Phonics

In phonics the children will be focusing on recapping their phase 2 and phase 3 sounds and learning tricky words. They will work in their own classes for the first week and then split up into phase groups. Look out for upcoming information telling you who your child's phonics teacher is.

Literacy

In Literacy, we will be focusing on writing simple sentences, which will include some tricky words. We will be making "Wanted" posters to help search for pirates and read clues to find treasure using maps.

Maths

We will continue to look at numbers up to 20 and make sure we are secure with this before beginning to move onto bigger numbers and quantities. We will also be reading, writing and ordering the numbers.
