This term we are learning...

This term in Year 1 our topic is "Where Do We Live?". In geography we will be learning about the countries that make up the UK, their capital cities and the surrounding seas. In science, we will be learning about materials and learning how to describe them using their properties.

Phonics

In phonics the children will work in their phonics groups. They will continue to learn the different sounds letters make and use these to read words. Children will also read books linked to their phonics ability and answer questions about what they have read.

English

In English we will be writing "Magic Box" poems about our favourite things. They will be using a variety of adjectives to describe their favourite objects. They will also be reading the story "King For A Day", which is a story set during the celebration of Basant in Pakistan.

Maths

During this half term the children will be learning about place value to 50 and measures including height and length.
