'Locala's School Nursing Teams work in partnership with families and education to support children and young people to ensure that their health needs are being met'.

Diamond Wood Community Academy commission a 0-19 School Nurse Practitioner, from Locala, who provides health support to children and families. Our current practitioner is called Beverley Batley and she can provide advice and help with the following issues:

- Hearing tests
- Height and weight checks and continued monitoring
- Toilet training and basic continence advice
- Behaviour and parenting advice
- Diet and eating problems
- General health advice and support



Beverley is in school every fortnight and her clinic can now be accessed by parents. The service is highly confidential and information will be kept strictly on a need to know basis. If you would like support you can either:

- 1. Discuss a referral with your child's teacher and they can make the referral
- 2. Complete the attached slip and hand it in to the main office or to the class teacher. Note -You do not have to disclose the reason for your referral
