Term-Time Leave Reminder

- ♦ An appointment must be made with the Head of School at least one month before making any travel arrangements. **DO NOT** book tickets prior to this meeting. Once booked, flight tickets **MUST** be presented to school.
- ♦ All holidays/extended leave in term time are **UNAUTHORISED**.
- ♦ After 20 (school) days of unauthorised leave your child will be removed from roll and he/she will be referred to Kirklees Council's Children Missing Education Team. This means that you will have to re-apply for a school place upon your return, and this could result in him/her being offered a place at another school.
- ♦ Penalty Notices will be issued to each parent for each child. The Penalty Notice is for £60 for each parent of each child if paid within 21 days, and £120 if paid after this date but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice could result in the Local Authority starting legal proceedings against you for the offence of not ensuring your child's attendance at school. If prosecuted, the fine is up to £1000 and you will have a criminal record.
