This term we are learning...

This term in Year 1 our topic is 'The Great Outdoors'. In History we will be learning all about a significant individual who is local to West Yorkshire. In Art we will focus on the work of Georgia O'Keeffe and paint our own flowers in the style of her work. In Science lessons we will learn about plants and animals.

Phonics

In Phonics the children will continue to work on knowing the Phase 3 and Phase 5 phonemes. They will be reading words containing these phonemes and then using them to write sentences.

English

In English we will be focusing on the story of 'The Train Ride.' We will be re-writing sections of the story using ambitious vocabulary and then writing our own versions of the story. We will be focusing on using capital letters, full stops with finger spaces, as well as adjectives and conjunctions.

Maths

The children will continue working on addition and subtraction. We will also focus on counting in 2's, 5's and 10's, as well as place value and money.
