This term we are learning...

This term in Year 1 our topic is 'Outdoor Explorers'. In history we will be learning all about a significant individual who is local to West Yorkshire. In art we will focus on the work of Georgia O'Keeffe and paint our own flowers in the style of her work. In science lessons we will learn about plants and animals.

Phonics

In phonics the children will work in their phonics groups. They will continue to learn the different sounds letters make and use these to read words. Children will also read books linked to their phonics ability and answer questions about what they have read.

English

In English we will be focusing on the story of 'Jack and the Jelly Bean Stalk.' We will be re-writing sections of the story using ambitious vocabulary and then writing our own versions of the story. We will be focusing on using capital letters, full stops, adjectives and conjunctions.

Maths

During this half term the children will work on money, fractions of shapes and amounts. Children will also practice finding double and half of numbers.
